On Sunday, March 31, Ambassador Sulunteh attended Easter Service with the Liberian community at the Friends in Jesus Ministries, a leading Liberian-oriented church in the Sacramento area. The service was well-attended and inspiring.

Following the service, Ambassador Sulunteh also participated in a town-hall meeting organized by ACFLi, during which he engaged members of the community relative to questions and concerns that they had regarding the state of affairs in Liberia and the Embassy in Washington, D.C.

The visit, which was his first to California, afforded him the opportunity to personally interact with people from all sectors of the Liberian community in the area, as a way of taking the Liberian Government to Liberians in the Diaspora.
