REPUBLIC OF LIBERIA COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR TRAVELERS Effective December 20, 2021

- All travelers **MUST** present a negative PCR COVID-19 test result obtained from an accredited laboratory within three days (72 hours) before departure.
- All travelers 18 years and above **MUST** show proof of full COVID-19 vaccination upon arrival. Liberia recognizes these vaccines as designated by the World Health Organization (Janssen/J&J, Pfizer-BioNTech; Moderna; AstraZeneca; Covaxin; Covishield; BIBP/Sinopharm; Sinovac).
- All travelers arriving into Liberia will be tested upon arrival, **regardless of COVID-19 vaccination status. The IMS strongly encourage all arriving passengers to isolate for seven (7) days, especially if you are arriving from countries that have reported cases of the Omicron variant.**
- **Testing fees for Incoming and Outgoing travelers:** ECOWAS citizens with trip originating from ECOWAS Countries must pay US\$50 for cost of COVID-19 testing while others arriving from countries outside the ECOWAS region must pay US\$ 75. Payments can either be made online or in cash at the UBA banking window.

It is the traveler's responsibility to check with the airline prior to travel for designation country COVID-19 requirements.

***EXEMPT TRAVELERS:** Diplomats, their families and honorary consuls are exempt from testing at Roberts International Airport (RIA) or other designated ports of entry. **However, the exempt status does not apply to Liberian diplomats without foreign assignment.** Diplomats are encouraged to isolate within their embassies or place of residence for seven (7) days before associating with the public. All Diplomats will be required to present proof of their COVID-19 vaccination.

Children under five years of age are exempt from all COVID-19 entry testing. However, for countries that require children to be tested, the stipulated fee will apply for out going travelers.
