President Boakai Visits the U.S. for a Strategic Meeting with President Trump

Washington, D.C. - July 7, 2025-

President Joseph Nyuma Boakai has been invited by U.S. President Donald J. Trump for a significant two-day working visit to the United States. This invitation highlights the strengthening diplomatic ties between Liberia and the United States and sets the stage for important multilateral discussions. President Boakai's visit is scheduled to take place from July 9 to 11. It will include strengthening the bilateral relations between the two nations. The visit is also part of a broader Africa diplomatic initiative of President Trump for which he has also invited Presidents Bassirou Diomaye Faye of Senegal, Brice Clotaire Oligui Nguema of Gabon, Mohamed Ould Ghazouani of Mauritania, and Umaro Sissoco Embaló of Guinea-Bissau. This multilateral gathering aims to foster collaboration in addressing regional security challenges and strengthening economic partnerships.
